Whistlestop Cafe has opened near the Lancaster Amtrak Station at 16 E. McGovern Ave. following a makeover to what had been A Loaf of Bread Bakery.

The bakery had been closed for several weeks as a new owner — Carol Brooks — oversaw some interior design changes as well as some additions to the menu and earlier hours.

The Whistlestop Cafe continues to feature organic pastries and breads but will be adding soups, sandwiches, salads, quiches and other prepared foods such as ratatouille and Rösti.

The cafe has seating for about 20, which may eventually be expanded.
